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Please read this form carefully. Enrollment (via Online Module) into Performing Group(s) indicates **ACCEPTANCE of all requirements on Spring Ballet 2023 Performance Contract** (Bullets 1-11) per dancer, per Concert Series. (Online Enrollment ENDS Jan. 7th, 2023. **Online Enrollment ENDS for BR Ensemble Jan. 5th, 2023.** (Refer to Spring Ballet 2023 Performer Enrollment Worksheet for details.)

- 1. I wish to have my child(ren) participate in Ballet Rincon's (BR) **Spring Ballet 2023 Coppelia** production series on **Fri., June 2nd**, 7pm, and **Sat., June 3rd**, 7pm, 2023, at the Vail Theatre of the Arts (VTOTA).
- 2. Spring Ballet 2023 *Coppelia* production will be held under VTOTA and Ballet Rincon's COVID-19 protocols.
- 3. We understand that this participation requires consistent attendance at classes and rehearsals, including **mandatory** Tech Week rehearsals at VTOTA (**May 30 – Jun 1**) and the **two mandatory** studio run-through rehearsals (**Sat., May 13th & May 20th**, 3:00-6:30 pm). We have been made aware of Ballet Rincon's policy regarding rehearsal absences and my child(ren)'s eligibility to perform. (**One excused** class/rehearsal absence allowed per dancer, per dance, before eligibility is in question.)
- 4. We understand that for performance participation as a **new performer** (Spring 2023) at Ballet Rincon, we must read and understand the terms of the New Performer Commitment Requirement Form. (See separate form.)
- 5. We understand that for Concert participation and to begin rehearsals we will be responsible for the non-refundable & non-transferable Spring Concert Series Concert Fee (\$85 per household), Costume(s)* Purchase (priced per costume; Required), Performance Tights* Purchase (priced per style; Required) and January Rehearsal Fee (See bullet #7). All are due by: Sat., January 7th, 2023.

- 6. We understand that Rehearsals for **Ballet Levels 1-10** will be scheduled outside of class time. It will be the responsibility of each dancer to check the Rehearsal Calendar on an on-going basis. Ballet Level 6-10 Rehearsal schedule posted at the studio and on BR website. Ballet Level 1-5 Rehearsals - See Schedule of Classes.
- 7. We understand that dancers in **Ballet Levels 1-10** will be responsible for a Rehearsal Fee. Rehearsal Fee Ballet Levels 1-5 - \$20 per dancer, per month (non-prorated), per performance season. Rehearsal Fee Ballet Levels 6-10 (Non-BR Ensemble) - \$30 per dancer, per month (non-prorated), per performance season. The Spring Ballet 2023 *Coppelia* performance season runs January-May, 2023.
- 8. We accept the inclusion of **One Promotional Code for two tickets** with the Concert Fee. Promotional Code may be applied to an online ticket purchase for **any of the three** performances of the Spring Concert Series performances: Fri 7pm Spring Ballet; Sat 2pm Spring Showcase (Preschool, Tap, Jazz, Modern & BR Ensemble); Sat 7pm Spring Ballet) All additional tickets sold separately. Tickets are for reserved seating. Theatre performance ticket prices are: \$16/\$20 for Mezzanine Seating and \$20/\$24 for Orchestra Seating. Online service fee applies. The online ticket sale kick-off for BR families will begin on Sat., April 29th, beginning at 9am Arizona time, <https://buy.Tututix.com/BalletRincon>. All additional tickets sales will be held online via <https://buy.Tututix.com/BalletRincon> and at the Vail Theatre of the Arts prior to curtain on **June 2nd & 3rd**.
- 9. We understand for Concert participation an adult representative from each family must agree to assist the school staff by signing the Performance Parent Helper Sign-Up Sheet posted online via www.signupgenius.com beginning Sat., Mar. 4th, through Sat., Apr. 29th. Sign-up is on a first-come, first-served basis, and families who have not signed by Sat., Apr. 29th will be assigned a position by the BR Parent Helper Coordinator.
- 10. We understand that this production is not simply a recital, but a professional performance achieved through many hours of hard work and cooperation among the dancers, staff and parent helpers, that will be enjoyed by our families and friends throughout the community.
- 11. Our family accepts this serious commitment and we will do our part to make this a professional, safe and rewarding program for all the dancers and families involved.
